Annual Meeting – 18th May at 11am in Holy Trinity

Each Parish Church is required to hold an Annual Meeting of Parishioners at which the Church Wardens are elected, and an Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) at which the Parochial Church Council (PCC) presents reports to the Church on any changes to the Electoral Roll; the finances of the Church; the Building and Fabric; and on the activities of the Diocese and Deanery that the Parish Church belongs to. New PCC members are also elected for a 3-year term at the APCM.

There are vacancies for 4 PCC members. If you are interested in standing for election there are nomination forms available on the Church website or by the PCC noticeboard. There is also a description of the responsibilities and a list of meeting dates available. These need to be handed to the PCC Secretary before the meeting.

Reports to read before the meetings are available on the Church website or at the back of Church.

Thy Kingdom Come – Thursday 29 May to Sunday 8 June (Ascensiontide)

Thy Kingdom Come (TKC) is a global ecumenical prayer movement that invites Christians around the world to pray from Ascension to Pentecost for more people to come to know Jesus.

Since it began in May 2016, God has grown TKC from a dream of possibility into a movement, which unites more than a million Christians in prayer, in nearly 90% of countries worldwide, across 85 different denominations and traditions – so that friends and family, neighbours and colleagues might come to faith in Jesus Christ.

At Holy Trinity, we are joining with Christians around the world to pray, at home, in the Prayer Room in Trinity House, in the church (wherever works best for you), and there will be special times of prayer online or in person. Mission focus, May 2025 – Embrace Warwickshire

Embrace is a Christian organisation supporting female on-street sex workers in Coventry, with a new branch recently started in Birmingham. They aim to build relationships, demonstrating that each woman is deeply loved and precious to God, and that they are seen, known and loved.

Volunteers meet the women on the streets, and offer food, drink, hygiene products, conversation, and prayer when appropriate. Later their project manager provides further support, helping to stabilise their lives, working with other agencies in the city as needed. They will visit us and talk about their work on Sunday May 11th.


FIRST ENCOUNTER CONCERT & PLAY THE ORGAN SESSIONS
