Star-studded opening to the Autumn Recital series

We at Holy Trinity Coventry are delighted to present *nine* outstanding recitals in Autumn 2026

We are delighted to begin our Autumn series of recitals by welcoming to Holy Trinity the on Wednesday 2nd September (1.15pm) the renowned British pianist, **Jill Crossland**. And on Saturday 12th September (1.00pm) Pianist and Music Theatre Director **Connor Fogel**.

Jill Crosland is an English pianist, born in [Yorkshire](#). She studied at [Chetham's School of Music](#) and the [Royal Northern College of Music](#) in [Manchester](#), and with [Paul Badura-Skoda](#) in Vienna. She specialises in [Baroque](#) and Classical repertoire, with a focus on the music by [Johann Sebastian Bach](#), playing it on the piano. Remarkably, she has performed his [Well-Tempered Clavier](#) (48 Preludes and Fugues) from memory since her student years.

Prize-winning Musical Director and Pianist **Connor Fogel** enjoys a varied career as a director in musical theatre, as a concert pianist and as a notable musicologist. Connor Fogel studied piano at the *Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama* in Cardiff and gained a Master's degree in Musical Direction from *Mountview Academy of Theatre Arts* in South London.

His album *Rediscovering Liszt*, which contains historically authentic recreations of recital programmes performed by Liszt, was released in 2026 on Prima Facie records. His work in theatre includes *Chicago*, *The Phantom of The Opera*, *The BFG*, *Hello Dolly!*, *The King and I*, *Les Miserables*, and *As You Like It*, *The Taming of the Shrew* and *Measure for Measure* for the Royal Shakespeare Company

Tear Fund

Tearfund is a Christian charity, founded in 1971, which works with churches in more than 50 of the world's poorest countries. It was initially a 'relief fund' bringing aid to areas affected by natural disaster or famine. They also now have long-term church-based programmes to reduce poverty through sustainable development, and to challenge and relieve human suffering caused by human greed, injustice, and climate change.

Our Harvest Celebration (Sept 27th) will again have our Youth Group present the work of Tearfund's 'Transforming Communities' programme; this year focussed on eradicating extreme poverty in a rural community in Malawi.

Elections to General Synod

New members are being elected to General Synod this year – and you are invited to stand as a candidate.

General Synod is the national assembly of the Church of England. It shapes and approves laws that affect the whole of the Church of England. It agrees new forms of worship, debates matters of national and international importance and approves the annual budget for the work of the Church at national level.

Elections are happening for new General Synod members during summer 2026.

Diocese of Coventry will be electing three clergy members and three lay members.

Nominations open on Friday 14 August and close on Monday 7 September.

If you are interested in standing for election, please check the eligibility requirements below. You will need to be nominated by two people who are each 'qualified electors'. The qualified electors for these elections are current lay deanery synod members (for lay nominations) and most members of the clergy (for clergy nominations). Please contact elections@coventry.anglican.org with any queries.

How do I nominate myself?

Candidates who are qualified electors: you will receive an email from Civica Election Services on 14 August with a personal link to the nomination portal.

Candidates who are not qualified electors, or who prefer not to use the nomination portal: please use either this [CLERGY NOMINATION FORM](#) or [LAY NOMINATION FORM](#).
